Art and design	Use oil pastels to create a piece of artwork that shows the Mountains located in South America.	Create a piece of artwork that shows the Amazon Rainforest.	Use oil pastels to create a piece of artwork that shows the deserts located in North America.
Maths / English	Create a non-chronological report which answers the question: What is lifelike in North America?	Create a rain gauge and measure the rainfall over the period of a week. Display this data in different ways (e.g. table, graph).	Write a diary of someone who lives in the Amazon Rainforest. Remember to think about how they would be feeling and what they would get up to in their day to day life.
Big Question	Find out and present the information to: Life in the Amazon rainforest is different to life in Alaska?	Deforestation is always bad. Do you agree? Explain your answer.	What do you think will happen to the indigenous people within the Amazon Rainforest in 100 years?
