Fathers Day

The PSA are excited to tell you about our next event. We will be organising a Special persons'/Father's Day event, following the same format as the pop-up shop for Mother's day/Special persons', where the children can purchase several gifts for their loved ones. The cost is £4, if the child can bring this money to school from Monday 5th June to Friday 9th **June** and give to in a sealed envelope with the child's name and class they are in to one of the PSA on the gate. Someone from the PSA will be on the gate every morning at drop off to allow the children to do this. The children will then be allowed time in the afternoon of the 9th June to come and choose their gifts. They will be given a bag and can choose 3+ gifts that they would like to give, there will be up to 8 gifts to pick from. We hope that your children will love this and choose those special gifts for you.

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Confirmation

Our Confirmation service for 2023 is coming up on Sunday 18th June 10.30am, at Witham on the Hill when the Bishop will be with us. We've been sharing our Confirmation Sessions during Collective Worship and any year 5/6 pupil is eligible to be Confirmed. No further preparation will be needed, apart from a short rehearsal for the service. Confirmation completes what began at our Baptism (Christening), we become a full member of the Church and begin to receive Holy Communion (the bread and wine at the Eucharist). It also qualifies us to be a Godparent in the future! If your child would like to be Confirmed but hasn't been baptised (Christened) that can also happen as part of the service. If any parent is interested in being Confirmed at the service that is also perfectly possible.
