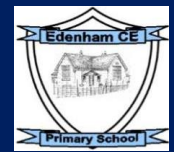

On Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July, it will be a non-uniform day. There will be no charge for this, but if you could bring in a prize for the tombola in the following colours:

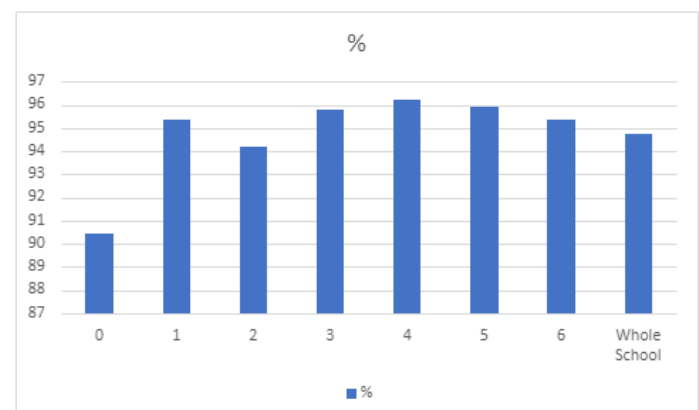
Jeffers & Dahl Class – Pink, Yellow or Purple

## Transition

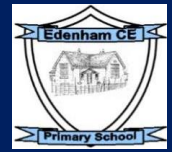
