Art and design	<p>Design and draw Indian elephant artwork with pencils or paints.</p> 	<p>Draw around your hand and create a Mehndi design.</p> 	<p>Create a Rangoli pattern using a variety of patterns and vibrant colours.</p> 
Maths / English	<p>Write a short non-chronological report that includes facts that you have learnt about India. For example: What continent is India a part of? What is the weather like? How many people live there? What is its capital city? What animals live there? What famous landmarks can be found there?</p>	<p>Read the Jungle Book by Rudyard Kipling, or a summary of it. Plan and create your own animal adventure set in the Indian Jungle.</p>	<p>Research the Space Race between the USSR and the USA. Create your own timeline of the key events. Then, choose some of those dates (e.g. 1969) and find different ways of adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing to make those numbers.</p>
Big Questions (demonstrate your answers to these however you see fit)	<p>Research the Solar System and answer the question: Are planets really that different from one another?</p> <p>Present your findings in the most creative way that you can!</p>	<p>Why is tea so important to India?</p> <p>Think about culture, trading and the impact this might have on daily life.</p> <p>There are lots of different jobs involved in the production and sale of tea – you could focus on one job role as part of your research.</p>	<p>What is it that makes astronauts so effective in space?</p> <p>Research astronaut fitness regimes, and physical and mental tests that they must pass.</p> <p>You could use different ways of presenting your research instead of just writing, including diagrams, tables and graphs.</p>
