Art and Design	Portrait Painting/Drawing – Create a portrait of either Florence Nightingale or Edith Cavell using pastels, paints, or collage.	Lantern Craft – Create a Florence Nightingale lantern using a cardboard tube and tissue paper to represent her carrying a lamp through hospitals.	Silhouette Art – Make a silhouette of one of the nurses and decorate the background with facts about them.
English/Maths	Timeline of Events – Create a timeline of one of the nurses' lives, showing key dates with simple illustrations.	Diary Entry – Write a diary entry as Florence Nightingale or Edith Cavell about a day in their lives.	Letter Home – Write a letter from the perspective of a soldier who was treated by either nurse, thanking them for their care.
