## Our eurriculum.....What makes me, me?

This term our connections topic continues to explore ourselves, our local environment, our aspirations and similarities and differences with other cultures and customs. We are thinking about our aspirations, different jobs and people who help us. If you have an interesting job or know someone who does and are willing to come into school and talk to the class please let Mrs Robinson know.

In phonics we are making good progress with recognising sounds, blending and beginning to read. We have now completed the teaching of the set 1 single letter sounds and the children are retaining these phonemes really well. This term we will continue to consolidate these phonemes and digraphs and move onto more blending as we learn to read.

Our maths this term will focus on shapes, patterns, spatial awareness and consolidating numbers to 10. This includes recognition and composition of numbers to 10.

Our science topic is 'seasonal change as autumn becomes winter' we will be looking at how the weather, light and dark change, the trees and what changes for plants and animals in winter. We will also be exploring animals and their habitats.

Our weekly outdoor education sessions with Mrs Robinson continue this term. This will include developing maths, our big questions, writing and art. These will continue every Wednesday please can children come to school in indoor footwear and bring their wellies for outside. The weather is changing so please ensure the children are layered up and appropriately dressed.

In D.T we will be designing and crafting our very own Christmas tree decoration.

In RE this term we will be looking at understanding Christianity exploring the question 'Why do Christians perform the nativity at Christmas?' This will link to our exposure to and discussions about the nativity story and performance of this.

In PSHE we are celebrating differences and looking at what makes us special and unique. We will be exploring differences between families, houses and personal strengths. We are learning how to be respectful to each other and discussing words to use to stand up for ourselves when someone is being unkind.

And of course Christmas is coming. We are excited to enjoy lots of Christmas crafts, baking and getting the glitter out!
