

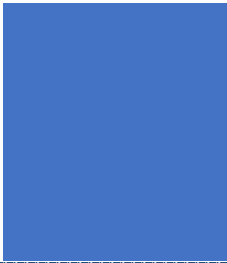


Jeffers Class Homework Menu – Spring 1
