You could make a hole in either end of the leaves and then thread them onto a piece of string. Don't forget to put them in the correct order!

You could then put up your homemade number line in your bedroom to help you remember the order of the numbers.

I wonder what is happening in the picture? Talk to your grown up about what you think has happened or what you think will happen next.

Count how many steps it takes you to get from one side of a room to another. Which room takes the most steps.

How many items in your house have a number on them? Which objects have the most numbers or fewer numbers?
