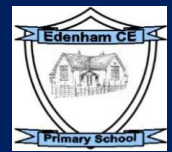

Autumn Term Parent Questionnaire



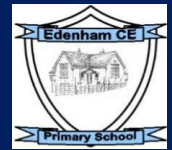
Attendance
