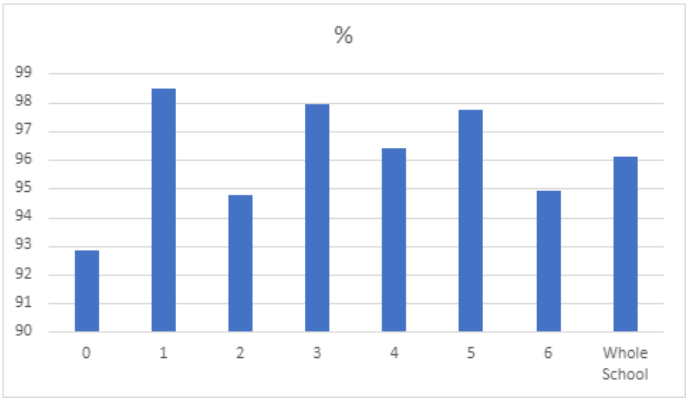
## School Clubs

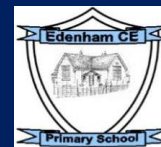
## Prospective Parents
