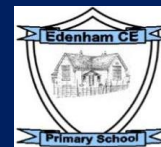

The children have been busy generating ideas which have then been used through team-building activities.

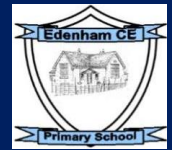

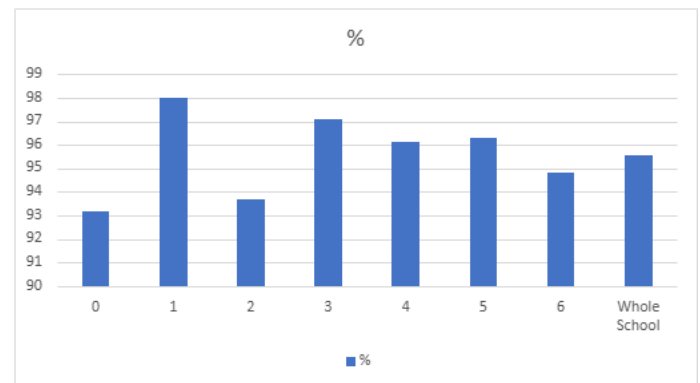
Allergies
