Privacy notice for Directors and Local Board Members: those involved with our schools on a voluntary basis

LAAT has the legal right and a legitimate interest to collect and process personal data relating to those who work with LAAT on a voluntary basis, in the capacity of Director and/or Local Board Member. We process personal data in order to meet the requirements set out in UK academy and safeguarding law, including those in relation to the following:

- Academy Funding Agreement and Articles of Association
- Academy's legal and statutory framework
- Safeguarding Vulnerable Groups Act 2006
- The guidance "Keeping Children Safe in Education"
- The Childcare (Disqualification) Regulations 2009

This personal data includes identifiers such as names, contact details and date of birth.

If Directors and Local Board Members fail to provide their personal data, there may be significant consequences, including the failure to meet legal compliance. Personal data is only sought from the data subject. No third parties will be contacted to obtain Directors' or Local Board Members' personal data without the data subject's consent unless the law requires the Trust to do so.

In accordance with the above, Directors' and Local Board Members' personal data is used for the following reasons:

- Legislative compliance
- Safeguarding and Safer Recruitment requirements
- Governance administration and processes

We will not share information about you with third parties without your consent unless the law allows us to. We are required, by law, to pass on some of this personal data to:

- The relevant local Council in the areas we operate
- the Department for Education (DfE)

Where necessary, third parties may be responsible for processing Directors' and Local Board Members' personal information. Where this is required, LAAT places data protection requirements on third party processors to ensure data is processed in line with Directors' and Local Board Members' privacy rights.

Directors' and Local Board Members' personal data is retained in line with the Records Management Policy.

Data will only be retained for as long as is necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was processed, will not be retained indefinitely and complies with the Records Management standards.

As the data subject, you have specific rights to the processing of your data.

You have a legal right to:

- Request in writing access to the personal data that LAAT holds.
- Request in writing that your personal data is amended.
- Request in writing that your personal data is erased.
- Request in writing that the processing of your data is restricted.

Where the processing of your data is based on your explicit consent, you have the right to withdraw this consent at any time. This will not affect any personal data that has been processed prior to withdrawing consent.

Directors and Local Board Members also have the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) in relation to how LAAT processes their personal data.
